For the early riser

- 1 **Revolver**: When you like your coffee black.
- 2 Nemesis: With three vibey locations, you're spoilt for choice. Our picks? The Shipyards outpost in North Vancouver is a hop-skip-and-jump from Waterfront Station by Seabus and should be paired with a visit to Polygon Gallery. Or hit up The Great Northern Way café, which features a sculptural pavilion – right next to the Emily Carr University of Art + Design.
- 3 Birds & the Beets: Great coffee, even better lunch. Bonus – this spot transforms into Juice Bar in the evenings, serving natural wines.
- 4 Federal Store, (5) Oh Carolina, and (6) Marché St George. Quaint and cozy pocket cafes.
- 7 **Mon Pitou Bistro & Bakery**: In the mood for brunch with your coffee? You've come to the right place.

For the curious

- 8 **Granville Island**: Industrial area turned tourist mainstay, for good reason. Wander the market, duck into the shops, tip the buskers, and brave the queue for Lee's Donuts (trust us).
- 9 Brewery/mural crawl in Mount Pleasant: bcaletrail.ca lays out all the best brews, while vanmuralfest.ca is your guide to the biggest art in the city.
- 10 Sunset at Sunset (Beach): Have your nightcap at the Sylvia Hotel bar – nostalgic, unpretentious, and great for people watching.
- 11 Hit Commercial Drive: Eclectic mix of shops, cafes, and restaurants. Check out Found and Freed for rustic antiques and Attic Treasures for Danish and mid-century modern finds.
- 12 **Centre A Gallery**: Contemporary Asian art gallery and library.

For the foodie

- 13 **Phnom Penh**: City-famous chicken wings, in the heart of Vancouver's historic Chinatown district.
- 14 **Tacofino**: the recipe for the city's best fish tacos originates from Tofino, Canada's unofficial surf capital so you know they're legit.
- 15 Do try **Do Chay**: Serving vegan/vegetarian Vietnamese in Yaletown.
- 16 **Tavola**: Our go-to neighborhood Italian joint.
- 17 **Vij's**: Hollywood actor and BC local, Ryan Reynolds, rates it the best Indian restaurant in the city. We concur.
- 18 Miku: Sushi done right.
- 19 **Maenam**: Refined Thai cuisine by celebrated Chef, Angus An.
- 20 **Kissa Tanto**: New kid on the block, serving up Italian-Japanese fusion dishes.
- 21 **Autostrada Vancouver House**: Mouthwatering Italian fare, served with a side of iconic architecture alla Bjarke Ingels Group
- 22 **Oca Pastificio**: Heavenly handcrafted pasta. Need we say more?
- 23 **Savio Volpe**: Viva la convivialità! Tuck in with friends and strangers at this modern-styled Italian osteria.

- 26 Inform Interiors: Luxe home design.
- 27 Old Faithful Shop: Curated household essentials, built to last.
- 28 Your next design book will be found at Vancouver Special.
- 29 Much & Little: Sweet and cheerful gift shop.

For the archi-tourist

- 30 **Robson Square**: This vibrant public plaza designed by Arthur Erickson and Cornelia Oberlander is Vancouver's undisputed beating heart.
- 31 **Polygon Gallery**: Go for the art and views, stay for the contemplative architecture.
- 32 **Vancouver House**: A tricky triangular site proved no obstacle for BIG's gravity-defying tower.
- 33 **Alley Oop* and Ackery's Alley***: With a little vision (and a lot of paint) these once-neglected laneways have become magnets for public connection.
- 34 **Concord Pacific Pop-up Park***: No park? No problem. This pop-up park transformed 3.5 acres of asphalt into a fun haven for local residents.
- 35 **Edmonds Community Centre***: Multi-generational, multi-cultural, multi-service.
- 36 Grandview Heights Aquatic Centre*: Finding beauty and function in the unconventional, underneath the world's longest timber catenary roof.
- 37 Clayton Community Centre*: North America's first Passive House certified community centre is a lesson in communityinspired design.
- 38 **Westminster Pier Park***: Hit the boardwalk and take in the Mighty Fraser this 2.5km waterfront park is cleverly built on land and river with 3,600 pilings.
- 39 **Hillcrest Centre***: Lasting legacy from the 2010 Olympic curling venue to Vancouver's best-loved recreation hub.
- 40 University of British Columbia (UBC) Aquatic Centre*: A delicate balance of elite-level training and competitions, and daily community use.
- 41 **Minoru Centre for Active Living***: Recreation for wellness, at every stage of life and why not take a dip in Canada's largest hot tub while you're there?
- 42 **Richmond Olympic Oval*:** Its iconic WoodWave roof is a sight to behold you may need a neck massage after.
- 43 **West Vancouver Community and Aquatic Centre*:**The Atrium is the social, breathing heart of West Vancouver.
 Grab a coffee from the cafe and simply hang out.

For the active

- 44 Kayak False Creek or (45) Deep Cove.
- 46 Take a quintessential stroll around the **Stanley Park Seawall** all the way to Granville Island or (47) **Kitsilano Beach**.
- 48 Bare all with a sunbathe and skinny dip at Wreck Beach.
- 49 Test your mettle at the Capilano Suspension Bridge or, if you're in the mood for hiking trails, its humbler complement at (50) Lynn Canyon Park.
- 51 Tackle the **Grouse Grind** and earn a local badge of honour but we won't tell if you opt to take the cable car up instead!
- 52 Hike **Mount Seymour's Dog Mountain**. The reward? Jaw-dropping views of the city.
- 53 Picnic among old growth giants at Lighthouse Park.
- 54 Stop and smell the roses at **VanDusen** and (55) **UBC** botanical gardens, or (56) Queen Elizabeth Park.
- 57 Keep an eye out for sea otters and bald eagles on the picture-perfect **Ambleside to Dundarave** sea walk in West Vancouver.
